- 1. Maintenance of optimum health care through proper vaccinations, worming and veterinary care as needed.
- 2. Planning each litter with care and only breeding dogs of sound body and temperament.
- 3. Keeping all official registration papers and contracts in accordance with the rules and regulations of the registering body.
- 4. Never selling dogs to pet stores or commercial dog brokers, nor selling or giving dogs for scientific research, or for any kind of promotional activity such as a prize in a raffle.
- 5. Obtaining a fair price for dogs because time and money has been invested to ensure quality pets and show dogs.
- 6. Good sportsmanship in the conformation/obedience ring/ or any other dog related activity is expected.
